NEW 2010 Alabama State Championship Jersey Design

We need to come up with a new and different design from those of the past. For you new riders, there are a few riders who wear the old state jerseys that you can look at to see the past designs. Everyone should think of something original in the creation of his or her design, old or new school, cool, but awesome, something to make your design stand out in the crowd. Make your design something so great that everyone from Alabama, and maybe people from other states, will want to wear your jersey at every race. Remember that concept is more important than your choice colors. Designs can be created with whatever means you have available, from pencil and paper to computer created.

For those who don't know, each year at the Annual Presidents Cup BMX Race, a top State Jersey Design is chosen. Alabama has never won, but wouldn't it be great to say "**my jersey design won as best design over all other states**". For you new riders who don't know what the President Cup Race is all about, it is a BMX race held every year where riders from each state compete against each other... it's a state -vs.- state BMX race to determine the best in the country. Attached are jersey template sheets for you to use in creating your breathtaking design. Use one for Front Design and one for Back Design. As in the past, there are no limits to how many different designs a rider may submit; only that all designs must be submitted before the DEADLINE of August 31st 2010. Entries can be submitted at your local track or directly mailed to the State Commissioner. The address is listed below. Remember if your design is chosen, the winner will receive the following: 1) Your signature will be placed on the jersey as a part of the design, 2) your entry fee's for the 2010 Alabama State Championship will be paid by the state, and 3) you will be recognized at the championship race and banquet as the winner of the contest.
